**Después de La Muerte...**

Durante el mes de noviembre, La Iglesia Católica ora específicamente por las almas de los fieles difuntos.

Oramos a Dios Padre por nuestros seres queridos que han fallecido para que El tenga misericordia de ellos, y para que el tiempo de purificación de sus pecados en el purgatorio se termine pronto. Las almas del purgatorio tienen gran necesidad de nuestras oraciones. Esto es un gran acto de misericordia. Ellas, que afortunadamente murieron sin pecado mortal, tienen que ser purificadas totalmente para poder entrar al Reino de los Cielos.

Muchos santos han dicho que a la medida que oramos por ellas, otros orarán por nosotros si un día vamos allá. Las lecturas de hoy (2 Mac 7:1-2, 9-14 y Lc 20: 27-38) hablan de la Resurrección. Hoy nos recordamos que ciertamente hay vida después de la muerte. La muerte no es el final, sino el principio a la próxima vida.. El alma es inmortal pues vive para siempre. La muerte consiste en la separación del alma y el cuerpo. El cuerpo, en el día de la Resurrección de los muertos, será unida al alma, y cada ser humano irá ante Dios para ser juzgado. Solo los que son *“juzgados dignos de [la vida futura] y de la resurrección de los muertos”* (Lc 20:35) vivirán para siempre con el Autor de la Vida. Sin embargo, *“el juicio será sin misericordia para el que no ha tenido misericordia; pero la misericordia triunfa sobre el juicio.”* (Stgo 2:13) *“Que las almas de los fieles difuntos, por la misericordia de Dios, descansen en paz. Amén.”*

**After Death...**

During the month of November the Catholic Church prays specifically for the souls of the faithful departed. We pray to God our Father for our loved ones who have died so that He may have mercy on them, and so that He may shorten the time they need to spend in purgatory being purified of their sins. The greatest act of mercy we can offer to the souls in purgatory is to lift up to God those very prayers they have great need of. These souls, who fortunately died without mortal sin, need to be purified completely to be able to enter Heaven. Many saints have said that inasmuch as we pray for the souls in purgatory, others will pray for us if one day we are there. Today's readings (2 Mc 7:1-2, 9-14 & Lk 20: 27-38) talk about the Resurrection. There is certainly life after death. Death is not the end but the beginning of the next life. The soul is immortal and therefore lives forever. Death consists of the separation of the soul and the body. The body, on the day of the Resurrection of the dead, will be united with the soul, and every human being will go before God to be judged. Only those who *“are deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead”* (Lk 20-35) will live forever with the Author of Life. However, *“judgment will be merciless to one who has not shown mercy; mercy triumphs over judgment.”* (James 2:12-13) *“May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen”*
