Saturday – December 1, 2007

Art – Archeology – Scripture – Various elements come together to color our understanding of scripture. Among those elements are religious art forms such as painting, sculpture, movies and TV. In addition, the discoveries of archeological digs help support or dispel certain Biblical facts. This one day workshop will take a look at these elements and how they affect us for better or worse.

### ***Cristo Rey***

Sobre la cruz de Cristo había un letrero en griego, hebreo y latín escrito por Pilato que decía INRI (en latín), que significa Jesús de Nazaret, Rey de los judíos. En verdad, Cristo es Rey del universo y de cada uno de nosotros. El ladrón arrepentido reconociendo la *realeza* de Jesús, le dice; “*Señor, cuando llegues a Tu Reino, acuérdate de mí.*” Y Jesús, desde *Su Trono* aquí en la tierra, le respondió, “*Yo te aseguro que hoy estarás Conmigo en el Paraíso.*” (Lc 23;35-43) Horas antes de ser crucificado, Pilato le pregunta a Jesús si El es rey. Jesús le contestó: “*Mi Realeza no es de este mundo. Si Mi Reino fuera de este mundo, Mi guardia habría luchado para que no cayera en manos de los judíos. Pero Mi Reinado no es de aquí.*” (Jn 18\_33b-37) Cristo es el Rey Todopoderoso, cuya sabiduría es infinita y cuyo amor es eterno. El único que ejerce *la verdadera autoridad suprema* es el Rey de Reyes, Jesucristo nuestro Salvador. ¡Para El nada es imposible! Su Reino es el Reino de Justicia, Paz, Amor, Verdad y Servicio. Como Rey, El gobierna el Cielo y la tierra, y nada puede suceder sin El permitirlo. El es quien tiene la última palabra. Al final de los tiempos, todos van a reconocer que Jesucristo es el Rey de las Naciones, y ante El toda rodilla se doblará. Cuando una persona deja que Cristo sea Rey de su vida, ella comienza a participar en Su Reino.

### ***Christ the King***

There was an inscription written by Pilate in Hebrew, Greek, and Latin on the cross of Christ that said INRI (in Latin), which means Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews. Christ is truly King. He is King of the Universe and of each and every one of us. The repentant criminal, recognizing the *royalty* of Jesus, said: “*Jesus, remember me when You come into Your Kingdom.*” Jesus, from *His Throne* on earth, replied, “*Amen, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise.*” (Lk 23: 35-43) Hours before being crucified, Pilate asked Jesus if He was King. Jesus responded: “*My Royalty does not belong to this world. If My Kingdom did belong to this world, my attendants (would) be fighting to keep Me from being handed over to the Jews. But as it is, my Reign is not here.*” (Jn 18: 33b-37) Christ is the Almighty King, whose wisdom is infinite and whose love is eternal. The only one who exercises a *true supreme authority* is the King of Kings, Jesus Christ our Savior. Nothing is impossible for Him! His Kingdom is a Kingdom of Justice, Peace, Love, Truth, and Service. As King, He governs Heaven and earth, and nothing can happen if He does not allow it. He alone has the last word. At the end of time, everyone will acknowledge that Jesus Christ is the King of all Nations, and before Him all knee shall bend. When someone allows Christ to be King of his or her life, that person begins to participate in His Kingdom.
