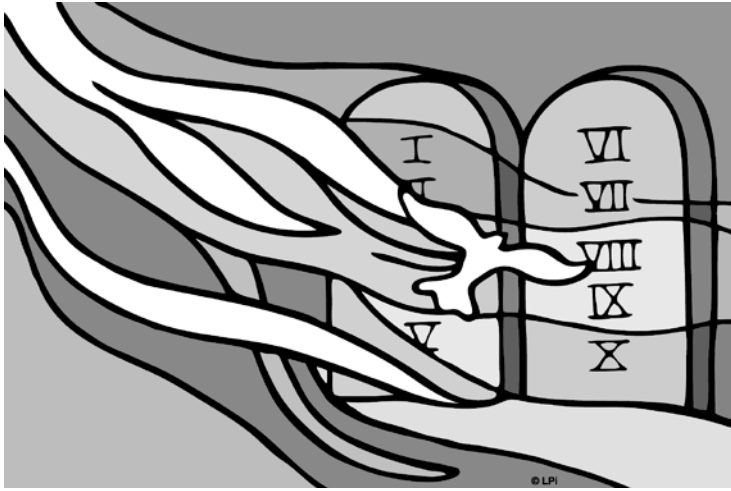

AMANDO A LOS DEMAS

“Amémonos los unos a los otros, porque el amor viene de Dios...” (2da lectura: 1 Jn 4, 7-10) Dios es amor, y Él comparte Su amor con nosotros, para que nosotros compartamos ese amor con los demás. Amar al otro es valorar a esa persona como una criatura de Dios, reconocer que ha sido creada con dignidad por el Dios de la vida con amor y por amor, y hacerle el bien que podemos y debemos, según pide la caridad. Hoy muchos dicen que conocen a Dios. Sin embargo, no valoran la existencia del niño nonato en el vientre, ni reconocen la dignidad que tiene como ser humano. Por consiguiente, no le hacen el bien que deben, que es respetar su vida y dejar que viva. Una razón por la que no aman ni respetan a la persona humana en el vientre es por falta de un conocimiento verdadero y mas completo de Dios. (1 Jn 4:8) Si alguien dice que el no-nacido no tiene que ser amado, respetado, o valorado, porque es demasiado pequeño, o porque no se ve, o por otra razón de interés personal, ¿que hubiera sido si la madre de esa persona hubiera pensado lo mismo? El cristiano tiene la obligación, por amor a Dios y al prójimo, de defender la vida humana desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural. Esta causa es mayor que cualquier otra causa. Por eso debemos preguntarnos: si se le niega la vida, ¿con que excusa nos justificaremos ante el Creador? Si la vida es el principio de todo, ¿que cosa sería de mayor importancia?

LOVING OTHERS

“Beloved, let us love one another, because love is of God...” (2nd reading: 1 Jn 4:7-10) God is love, and He shares His love with us, so that we may share it with others. To love the other is to value that person as a creature of God, to acknowledge that he/she has been created with dignity by the God of life with love and for love, and to do for the other the good that we can and must do, for the sake of charity. There are many who say that they know God. However, they do not value the existence of an unborn child in the womb, nor do they acknowledge the dignity that she has as a human being. Consequently, they do not do for her the good that they must, which is to respect her life and allow her to live. One reason why they do not love nor respect a human person in the womb is because there's a lack of a true and more complete knowledge of God. (1 Jn 4:8) If someone says that the unborn does not need to be loved, respected, nor valued, either because he is too small, or because he cannot be seen, or for another reason of personal interest, what would be of that person if his/her mother would have thought the same thing? The Christian has the obligation, for love of God and neighbor, to defend human life from conception until natural death. This cause is greater than any other cause. Therefore, one must ask: if an unborn child's life is denied, with what excuse would we justify ourselves before the Creator? If life is the beginning of all, what other thing is of greater importance?
