ENTREGA TOTAL

Lamentablemente, muchos piensan que para ser un buen cristiano deben hacer ciertas cosas. Se concentran en hacer las cosas que pide la Iglesia y que han aprendido como Católicos. Lo que muchas personas hoy día fácilmente olvidan es que si nos descuidamos, podemos comenzar a hacer las cosas por rutina o por obligación, y no por amor a Dios y para Su gloria. El hombre en el Evangelio de hoy (Mc 10, 17-30) le pregunta al Señor, “*Maestro bueno, ¿que debo hacer para alcanzar la vida eterna?*” y Jesús le contestó: “...*Ya sabes los mandamientos...*” El hombre le contestó: “*Maestro, todo eso lo he cumplido desde muy joven.*” El hombre tenía la costumbre, quizás de rutina, de cumplir los mandamientos. Pero cuando el Señor Jesús le pide algo mas que requiere una entrega total, el hombre se va muy triste. De aquí vemos que es nuestro deber y salvación cumplir los mandamientos de Dios y de la Iglesia, pero no debemos hacer estas cosas por rutina o por obligación, sino *vivirlas con todo el corazón*. Si vamos a hacer nuestras oraciones por la mañana, por la tarde y por la noche, vivamos nuestra oración, abriendo nuestros corazones con amor y confianza ante el Señor. Si vamos participar en la Santa Misa y participar en los sacramentos de la Iglesia, tratemos de vivir ese momento y cada momento presente por amor a Dios y para Su gloria. Cuando entregamos totalmente nuestro ser al Señor, todo lo que hacemos tendrá sentido: es para la gloria de Dios y la salvación de las almas.

TOTAL SURRENDER

Sadly, many think that in order to be a good Christian they must do certain things. They focus on doing those things asked of them by the Church and that they have learned as Catholics. What many today easily forget is that if we become careless, we can begin to do things out of obligation and routine, and not out of love of God and for His glory. The man in today's Gospel (Mk 10: 17-30) asked the Lord what *must he do* to inherit eternal life. Jesus answered him, “...*You know the commandments...*” The man replied to Him, “*Teacher, all of these I have observed from my youth.*” The man had the habit, probably of routine, of observing the commandments. But when the Lord Jesus asked him for something more which required total surrender, he went away sad. From here we see that it is our duty and our salvation to observe the commandments of God and the Church, but we must not do these things out of routine nor obligation, but *we must live them with all our heart*. If we are going to do our morning, afternoon and evening prayers, let us live our prayer, opening our hearts with love and trust before the Lord. If we are going to participate in Holy Mass and in the sacraments of the Church, let us make an effort to live that moment and each present moment for love of God and for His glory. When we totally surrender our being to the Lord, everything that we do will have meaning: it is for the glory of God and for the salvation of souls.
