### **SIGUIENDO AL SEÑOR DE VERAS**

Sí, nuestra vida tendrá nuevo sentido cuando verdaderamente escuchemos y sigamos al Señor. Junto con el Evangelio de la semana pasada, el Evangelio de hoy (Lc 9: 51-62) nos enseña el significado de seguir a Cristo. Tres personas se acercaron al Señor y al final ninguno de ellos le siguieron. La primera persona se dio cuenta que seguir al Señor no le será cómodo, y decidió no seguirle. La segunda persona recibió un llamado personal de Jesús a pesar de sus responsabilidades actuales. El Señor sabía que su padre, tarde o temprano, necesitará ser enterrado. Sin embargo lo llamó, dejándole saber a la segunda persona que es lo mas importante. La tercera persona le dijo a Jesús, “*Te seguiré, pero...*” y le puso excusas para no seguirle en ese momento. Ninguno de ellos supieron seguir al Señor. En verdad, debemos seguir al Señor no buscando nuestras propias comodidades, sino buscando la salvación nuestra y la de nuestros seres queridos. Todo sacrificio vale la pena cuando se trata de seguir a Cristo. Seguir al Señor debe ser nuestra prioridad en la vida, aún sobre nuestras responsabilidades actuales. Nada debe distraernos ni por un breve momento del seguimiento a Cristo. Dios nos llama y ante el Rey de Reyes los discípulos, nosotros, no tienen ninguna excusa valida en la vida para no seguirle según el llamado que Dios ha hecho. *Al final, seguir al Señor significa imitarlo.* La mejor manera de seguirlo es vivir como Él vivió y enseñó.

### **TRULY FOLLOWING THE LORD**

Yes, our lives will have new meaning when we truly listen and follow the Lord. Along with last Sunday's Gospel, today's Gospel teaches us the meaning of following Christ. Three people approached the Lord and, in the end, none of them followed Him. The first person realized that following the Lord would not be comfortable, and so decided not to. The second person received a personal calling from Jesus despite his current responsibilities. The Lord knew that his father, sooner or later, would need to be buried. Nonetheless Christ called him, letting him know what was most important. The third person said to Jesus, “*I will follow You, Lord, but...*” and gave excuses in order to not follow Him at that moment. None of them followed the Lord. Truthfully speaking, we must follow the Lord not seeking our own comfort, but seeking our salvation and the salvation of our loved ones. All sacrifices are worthwhile when it comes to following Jesus. Following Him should be our priority in life, even over our current responsibilities. Nothing, not even for a brief moment, should distract us from this priority. God calls us and before the King of Kings the disciples – each one of us – do not have any valid excuses in this life for not following God according to the call He has made. *In the end, to follow the Lord means to imitate Him.* The best way to do this is to live as He lived and taught.
